

**GURNARD:

Apologies:

Apologies were received from Liz Jackson, Richard Day & Bryan Salter.

Matters Arising from 31/10/05:

- a. The photo-shoot and award for Daisy Turton's street name sign design has not taken place.
- b. Nothing has been heard from Sheila Caws about the inclusion of Edwin Smith, so it was agreed to leave the bare mention of the name in "Historical Background" for now.
- c. There are currently 26 residents in 21 flats at Bucklers View – page 20 will be altered by **Miles Seymour** to reflect this.
- d. The Footpaths section is OK as completed on the draft publication, and the Street Lighting section should read "The photographic survey highlighted the need for improved street lighting in some areas".
- e. The list of organisations contacted at the start of the project is now included in Appendix 1.
- f. The process in the Forward section has now been replaced with a précis of the Parish Plan document in the 5th paragraph on page 2. All agreed it OK.
- g. One printer's quote has been received (Artpoints UK) for 50 copies with a 20 copy "run-on" - £478.50 + VAT for wire and £528.00 for saddle stitched. The "run-on" 20 copies - £220 + VAT, and £20 delivery. **Miles Seymour** will obtain 2 additional quotes.
