a. Report from Parish Clerk:

The following application has been approved:

**P/01288/11:** Lawful Development Certificate for proposed demolition of stable block. Detached double garage at Long Acre, Rew Street, Cowes.

Revised plans have been received for the following applications:

**P/01268/11:** Demolition of school. Outline for 7 dwellings with parking at Gurnard County Primary School, 27 Cockleton Lane, Cowes and no further comment is required.

**P/01102/11:** Demolition of single storey element. Proposed two storey side and rear extension to form additional living accommodation including dormer window and balcony on north elevation at 24, Solent View Road. The Case Officer advises that the application will be re-advertised shortly.
