1) MATTERS ARISING FROM 23 / 9 / 10 MEETING

It was reported that the Parish Council had written to Southern Vectis and Andy Morris airing our views.

It was noted that the double yellow lines called for by the TRO had been laid down.

A short report on the problems at 4-Cross gave us to understand that Northwood had talked to the IWC about this issue to no avail – any possible resolution was very low down on IWC priorities.

2) GENERAL VILLAGE TRAFFIC ISSUES

Following a complaint from a resident in Tuttons Hill about traffic speeds in Tuttons Hill, it was agreed to ask the Parish Council to write to Highways requesting monitoring equipment be installed for speed checking near to the last left hand house on the right going towards Gurnard, also to ask their advice regarding the apparent speeding problem and to write to Hampshire police asking them to check and enforce the 30 mph speed limit.

Hugh Robotham has had emails about coaches now using Church Road, Tilbury Road and the Avenue now that apparently they no longer use Church Road.

Comments were also made about the dangerous situation created in cold weather by the freezing of water coming off the fields adjacent to Cockleton Lane. Can the Parish Council ask for regular monitoring of the rain gullies along Cockleton Lane which might alleviate the ice problems.

We also felt that more regular inspections of Shore Road adjacent to the Solent Lawns development should be requested, following several members of the Working Party observing wet and extremely muddy conditions in that road.
