Walls and skirting and gas pipes all repaired/boxed in/ painted by David Payne

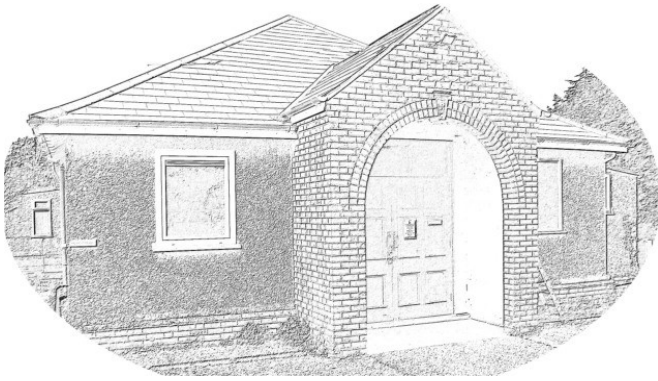
Art Exhibition went well - see financial statement

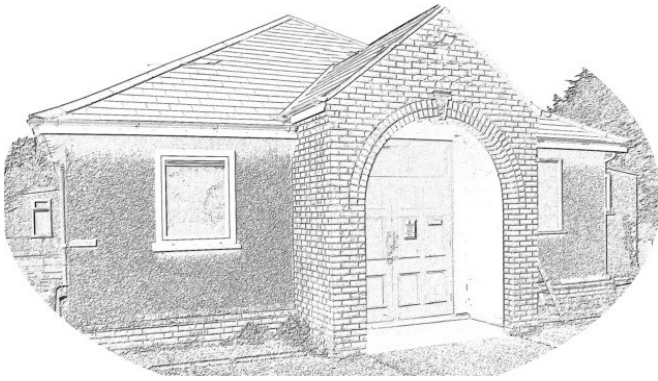
It was agreed that it was not so convenient for us in the field but that we will support village events. The theme is Wild West so doughnuts were suggested.
