Minutes

Finance

WP gave everyone a copy of the report and it was signed a true record by CS and WP. WP told us about British Gas errors, and also the costs of repairs to the gas heaters that Wight Energy obviously neglected.

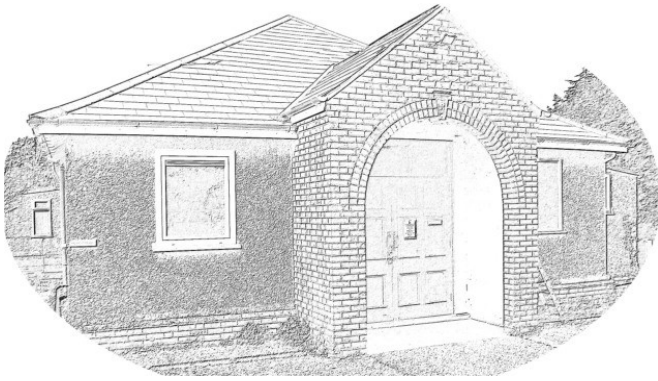
There is enough money to pay C£2000 for the shed erection and construction, with £2000 contingency plus some to cover other expenses.
