



A LETTER FROM ALL SAINTS'

As I write this letter it is only two weeks since we celebrated the birthday of Jesus, the babe of Bethlehem. The popular carol goes 'Love came down at Christmas. Love all lovely, Love divine'. Jesus subsequently grew up and showed us what real love is and how it can change the world. It is the completely unselfish and unconditional love which is directed outward, showing care and compassion towards others and seeking no reward.

Unfortunately society all too often displays the selfish kind of love which looks inward towards self and expects something in return. It may be the desire of 'one good deed for another' or the aim of getting 'brownie points' or even worse, 'self-glorification'. This kind of love is displayed by people in all walks of life, no matter what colour, faith or creed. But the only kind of love which can change everything for the better is the unselfish, sacrificial love of Jesus.

On February 14th we celebrate St. Valentine, the patron saint of lovers. He was a Roman priest at a time when Emperor Claudius II was persecuting the Christian church. Claudius prohibited the marriage of young couples because he believed that unmarried soldiers fought better for not having wives and families to worry about. It was also a permissive society in which polygamy was much more popular than marriage. But Valentine encouraged them to marry within the Christian church and married them in secret against Claudius' command not to. He was eventually caught and imprisoned. While in prison it is said that Valentine prayed with and healed the blind daughter of Asterius, one of the judges. It made such an impact on him that Asterius himself became a Christian.

In 269 AD Valentine was sentenced to death because of his stand for Christian marriage. The story goes that the last words he wrote were in a note to Asterius' daughter, which he signed 'from your Valentine'. This is said to be the inspiration behind the romantic sentiments of what we now celebrate as Valentine's Day. But while our thoughts of Valentine have invoked this more romantic side to our human thoughts and actions we should never forget that like many other saints and martyrs, Valentine stood up for his faith, his Christian values and principles, and in his desire to better the lives of others, in a completely unselfish and ultimately sacrificial way.

Perhaps we might take a leaf from his book and when we see someone in need we lay aside our own selfish desires and help without expecting a favour in return. Maybe even put ourselves out along the way. We may never need to sacrifice our life – but we can sacrifice a little comfort, a few pounds or a few hours. This month don't dwell on the cards, flowers, chocolates (although they will always be welcome!) but concentrate on the true meaning of unconditional, real love: Jesus thought we were worth it, I am sure your loved ones deserve it too.



Road Works.

First the Good news! I've been advised that following perseverance and support, Island Roads have moved forward their resurfacing schedule for **Parklands Avenue** from 2017 to September 2016.

Last month, I requested that the gully drainage and ponding which exists in both Parklands Avenue and **Baring Road** is investigated and action taken.

Elsewhere, I received calls from residents concerning roadworks being undertaken by utility companies. Initially this was raised concerning the closure of **Three Gates Road**, however similar issues have been reflected following the closure of **Worsley Road** and **Shore Road** at the same time in Gurnard. Following concerns, I spoke to Contractors and Island Roads. Subsequently, I'm advised it was necessary to close Worsley Road due to the depth of excavations and the narrowness of the road required for contractor to operate within HSE legal requirements.

As a result of weather conditions, this has delayed contractors parking on site. The contractor tells me he shares this frustration, as he is anxious to construct the road to service the new **Glen Place** development.

Cllr John Nicholson and I will be addressing issues concerning the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 with our MP. Of concern to us, is how this piece of legislation can be potentially abused by Utility Companies undertaking 'Emergency works'. A recent example of bad practice was when **Park Road** was dug up following resurfacing by Island Roads.

Isle of Wight Council Budget 2016/7.

I've attended briefings linked to next year's Budget, and how reduced Government funding continues to impact upon how and which services the IW Council delivers. Proposals on the future of the New Homes Bonus grant, discontinuation of Governments Financial settlement, the impact of the living wage, increasing Adult Social Care costs, and the extent to how local authorities can raise Council Tax is being analysed. This will impact on next year's precept, which is suggested will increase to its maximum level (3.99%)

New means, such as devolution are being explored on how Councils operate in the future. Unless new solutions are found, authorities including the Isle of Wight will fail to fulfil its statutory duties beyond 2017.

In meetings I've attended with Parish and Town Councils, it was made very clear for all Council's to work together to ensure those services considered most important are safeguarded. From my perspective, local councils fully understand the challenges faced and want to more to assist. When transferring services from Local Authority to Town/ Parish Council's, I'm working with colleagues to ensure this can be pursued in an easier way.

In light of this our Council Leader, Jonathan Bacon and our MP are again meeting with Ministers to underline what we believe is a unique case for our Island.

Medina Yard.

Meetings took place between businesses, Executive Members, and key officers to provide an insight as to challenges being faced. From my point of view, it's important for the IW Council to understand the needs of businesses to ensure they receive focused support.

I received some criticism for not opening up the meeting to more Councillors. In this instance, I felt compelled that businesses had the opportunity to be open and frank with Council leaders, and these views were in no way diluted.

GURNARD PARISH COUNCIL REPORT December and January

QUALITY PARISH COUNCIL

At the December and January meetings of the Parish Council the main topics discussed were:

REPORTED CRIMES

PCSO Derek Howard sent written reports. There have been 6 reported crimes in Gurnard during November and 5 in December. Community priorities remain the same.

NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

Meetings have re-started following the completion of the Landscape Assessment which will provide valuable evidence on the effect of development on the landscape of Gurnard. The next stage is to investigate various potential development sites and decide their suitability. Once all the evidence has been completed and the policies confirmed, the draft plan should be ready for publication for the Isle of Wight Council and Public Consultation.

OPEN SPACES PROJECT

200 tree samplings have been added to the site, plus the Community Growing Area has been rotivated. On the 24 February, 30-40 volunteers from the Green Gym will be clearing brambles and weeds from the site. The only cost to the Parish is £50 expenses. Once cleared, they will be disposing of the brambles and weeds by burning them on site. We apologise in advance for the smoke generated.

DISCRETIONARY SERVICES

Once again the Parish Council has agreed to fund the grass cutting on the green and top up the statutory service of beach cleaning to an acceptable level. From 1st April the Isle of Wight Council will cease funding the provision of public toilets across the Isle of Wight. The Parish Council has completed a visual inspection of the block on The Green and is requesting that the IW Council complete both a structural and drains survey before entering into negotiations. In the short term, councillors have agreed to take on the running costs of facility from the 1st April to ensure that it is kept open for use by residents and visitors.

QUEEN'S 90TH BIRTHDAY CELEBRATIONS

In line with many other parts of the country, the Parish Council is organising a "Clean for the Queen" event on Saturday 5 March 2016. This is a community litter pick to improve the environment for residents. All local groups are being invited to get involved, meeting at the Village Hall at 10am.

WHEELIE BIN ON THE SEAFROUNT

The Parish Council has agreed to fund the wheelie bin on the seafrount for a further year. The bin will be emptied on a monthly basis in the winter, weekly in the summer and bi-weekly if required. Please make the clerk aware of any problems with litter within the village.

The next full Parish Council meetings are at **7.00 pm** on **Thursday 11 February 2016.** Residents are welcome to attend all meetings, which are usually held at the **Gurnard Village Hall, Westbrook Lane**. 
