A LETTER FROM ALL SAINTS'

Hello there!

'Are you ready?' How often have you seen these words or perhaps said or heard this phrase? As a Mum of two young boys I say this phrase every day around 8am as I try to get myself and the boys out of the door for the school run, however I hear it in so many other places and in different scenarios - cooking and eating a meal,

commencing a church service, at the tills in Aldi, starting a race.....all the way to solicitors checking whether you are ready for death! Even Google is asking me the question this evening as I type this letter - apparently there is the 2016 Doodle Fruit Games in the latest Google app: dear Lord, and no, I have no idea what it means!

This phrase reminds me of a sketch comedian Michael McIntyre does about trying to leave the house when you have children. Whilst he is a little frenetic in his performance, it is hilarious, true, and hysterical - I would suggest you look it up on YouTube if you haven't seen it! In it he describes, in his most comedic style, the process of getting his family 'ready' to go out in the car and every time James and I are running out of the door trying to herd the boys into the car I think about this sketch and inwardly smile.

But the reality is we have never been more aware of time, or indeed been able to be ready than any other time in history - everything we have has the time on it: our watches (those of us who still wear them!), our phones, all electronic tablets, TVs, set top boxes, I could go on and on. I loved my time in Guiding and Scouting and was heartened to find out that the motto of the latter hasn't changed from when I was a girl - 'Be prepared' is what the youngsters are told to be, but how much would we benefit if we all kept to that motto: as Disraeli, British Prime Minster in

the late 1800s said, 'The greatest secret of success in life is for a person to be ready when their opportunity comes.' Disraeli said it, God tells us repeatedly, our nearest and dearest I am sure are regularly saying it - we need to be ready, for all adventures that lie ahead!

Young or old, active or frail, we all have adventures ahead and opportunities to try new or different things every day, whether you want to believe and acknowledge it or not, all we have to do is be ready for them and perhaps be prepared to challenge ourselves to move out of our comfort zones and do something we don't normally do.

So as the children get ready to start a new year and perhaps a new school this month, why don't you join the 'getting ready' gang and look for all the opportunities that pass your way....perhaps one could be entering our Harvest show! Waste Updates.

New Wheelie Bins and Food Caddies were issued to the new households in **Glen Place**. I am aware there remains confusion over what goes out and when. Please note most rubbish is now recyclable. Items that *currently* cannot be recycled and must be deposited in the black wheelie bin are:

Nappies, Sanitary Products, Animal Waste, Polystyrene, Plasters and dressings, Cold Ash, Sweet and crisp packets contaminated with food oil, Bubble wrap, Foil pet food pouches and pill blister packs. Please let me know if you have any questions, or if you have not received your receptacles.

Public Footpaths.

The IW Council are currently consulting on making the Islands Public Rights Of Way better. This continues until 16th September. Please visit www.iwight.com/consultations for details. Following a landslip the footpath CS4 linking Battery Road and Egypt Esplanade has been closed. Ground movement continues to be monitored, and the footpath will be reinstated once movement has stabilised. Discussions will take place this month between Natural England and Rights Of Way on the England Coast Path and the role and responsibilities for the Isle of Wight. I am positive that discussions will soon take place between residents and landowners affected.

The future for the Isle of Wight Council: Your views sought!

A number of residents regularly asked me what is devolution, and will the Isle of Wight really be absorbed into Hampshire in the coming years? Without me pre-judging what residents think, there is an ongoing consultation underway through a 'Solent Deal' partnership with our neighbouring Southampton and

Portsmouth Unitary Authorities. This consultation continues until 18th

Cowes Week.

Council-wise, Cowes Week was ever busy. Parking complaints and ensuring litter bins were emptied took up a significant amount of time this year. In advance of the holiday season the Council was persuaded to empty its bins on Gurnard Green daily, whilst I also required support from Environment Officers following an increase in beach parties this year. In addition during the summer the Marine Police were notified following jet-skiers coming in close to swimmers on our local beaches at both Cowes and Gurnard.

Hedgerows

Please continue to report overgrown hedgerows! Now the bird nesting season has concluded action is underway to deal with the consequences of this year's growing season. With Rights Of Way, these are taking longer than usual. In the meantime, please keep in touch and let me know of any issues which you are aware of!

Double Yellow Lines.

In the last few years I've received a number of requests for double yellow lines- But are there locations where double yellow exist, where you feel they are no longer needed? If so, please let me know!

Planning Applications.

Planning Applications for a new boat store in Marsh Road was conditionally approved. Following representations received, Planning Officers have confirmed the ridge height to not exceed 4.5m. On the former Gurnard school site in Cockleton Lane conditions have been amended to remove the pedestrian access to link the new development with Hilton Road. This follows comments from both myself, Gurnard Parish Council and Island Roads who raised concerns about this. On this matter Planning Officers considered these grounds were unsustainable to call-in this decision. One proposal to redevelop a property in Shore Road was conditionally approved, whilst another more controversial application was refused by Planners.

I met with residents from Marine View Close concerned with an application for nearby Queens Road. This proposal has been withdrawn by the applicant, and I'm ever hopeful that dialogue can take place between the applicant and neighbours affected.

There are a number of ongoing Planning Enforcement matters currently being pursued both in Cowes and in Gurnard. Enquiries are ongoing at Gurnard Pines, where a number of residential occupancies are alleged to be taking place in dwellings consented for tourism/ holiday only use.

Highways Matters.

Ward Avenue was reinstated ahead of schedule, whilst footway resurfacing is pending for Lammas Close and King James Close. Elsewhere, I've received an initial confirmation from Island Roads that Shore Road is due to be resurfaced 'mid-October', whilst I'm awaiting a confirmation for a start date for Parklands Avenue.

Street Naming: New Development, Place Road.

I've been approached by the developers of new homes to be built off Place Road. Standing by their commitment to engage with the local community, they have asked me, to ask for suggestions from the community to help potentially name roads for this new development. Initial suggestions put forward include West Solent Park, as the name for the new development, whilst Old Oak Road, West Point Road, Wild Cherry Road/ Drive are suggested as names for roads. The developers will market this as a prestigious housing scheme and they have requested that names should reflect this. They also suggest referencing the church and its spire, on the opposite of the Jordan Valley. If you have alternative ideas for the name of this new development and its roads, please let me know and I will forward these to developers and Gurnard Parish Council. As an added incentive, the developers are offering 3 x £50 meal vouchers at local restaurants for the best suggestions! The deadline for suggestions is 12 noon, Monday 5th September.



Plenty to keep everyone occupied and a big thankyou to Ric Ambridge and his team for sorting this out.


