1 APOLOGIES

There were apologies received from Councillors Doughty and McKean.

2 DECLARATIONS OF PECUNIARY & NON-PECUNIARY INTERESTS

- a) Councillor Harrison declared a non-pecuniary interest in that he is an employee of the Isle of Wight Council.

Councillors Bugden and Jacobs declared non-pecuniary interests in that planning application P/00415/17 would have a visual impact on their properties.

4 PLANNING & LICENSING APPLICATIONS

- a. Councillor Fuller presented two applications. It was:
RESOLVED:
 - (i) That Gurnard Parish Council makes no objection to application numbered - P/00356/17 – 12 Princess Esplanade.
 - (ii) That Gurnard Parish Council makes no objection to application numbered P/00415/17 land south of Hornhill Copse and west of Rew Street – in that the mobile signal for the residents of Gurnard requires improvement but they would like the mast properly screened given its position in an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty.
- b. **RESOLVED:** That the Parish Council received two planning decisions.
 - (i) P/00137/17 Gurnard Village Hall - permission granted. The Parish Council made no comments as applicants.
 - (ii) P/00181/17 – 28 Albert Road, permission refused, the Parish Council raised objections.
